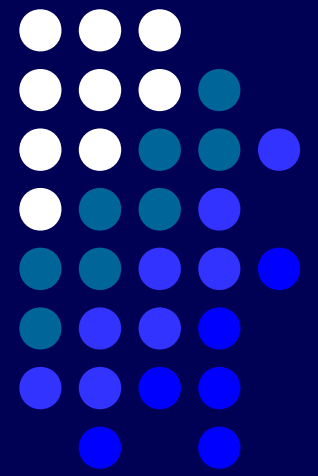

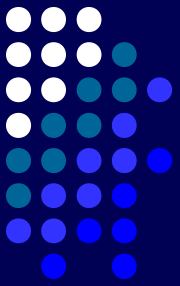

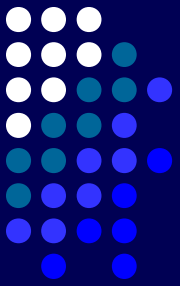

“...he that winneth souls is wise.”

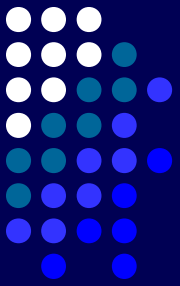

Stopped By A Police Officer



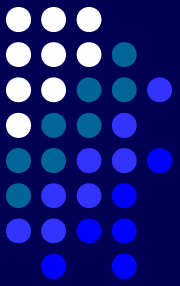
- Attended a witnessing and soul-winning class one Sunday night.

Stopped By A Police Officer



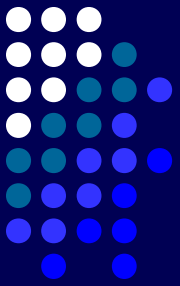

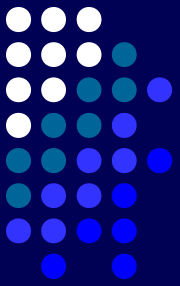
- “If you were to die today, do you know for sure if you would go to heaven?”

Compel Them To Come In



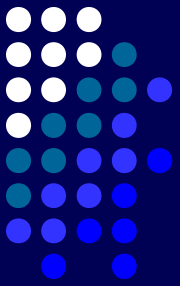
- Luke 14:23

Why Bother?



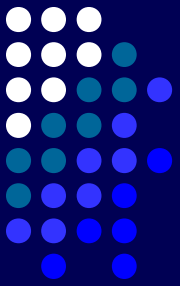
- There are more fun things to do.

Neighbor's House on Fire, Will You Warn Them?



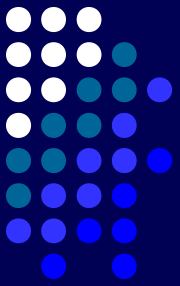
- You have more fun things to do.

Neighbor's House on Fire, Will You Warn Them ?



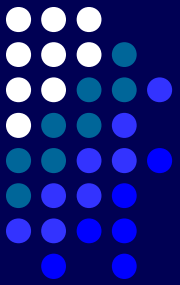
- What is the big deal?

Most People Don't Believe in Hell



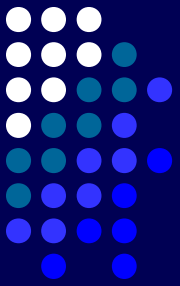
- Jesus believed in Hell.

If You Really Believed...



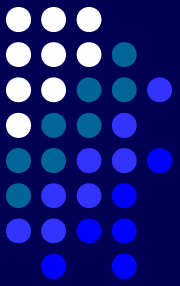
- If fire broke out downstairs in your neighbors house, while they were asleep upstairs. If you really believed that your neighbors might burn up would you try to save them from death by fire?

If You Really Believed...



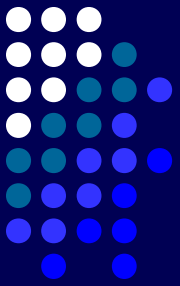
- If you really believe that the lost will die and suffer a burning torment in hell, would you try to save them?

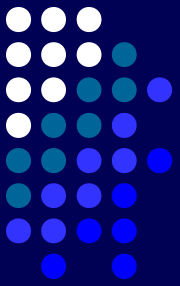

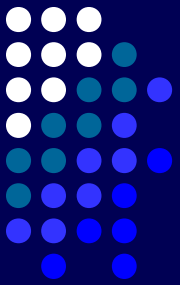

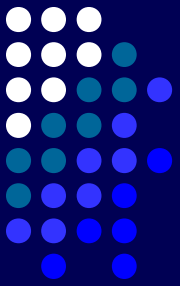

The Sower Is Joyful When It is Time to Reap



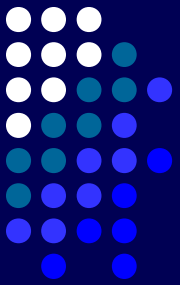
- “They that sow in tears shall reap in joy.”

The Sower Is Joyful When It is Time to Reap



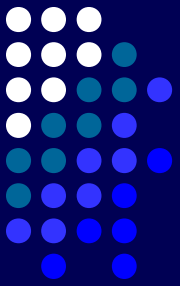
- What is the seed? (Luke 8:11)

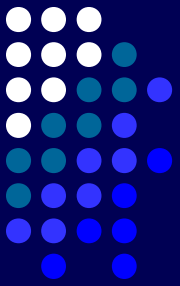

Jesus Sends Us (But Less Than 2% Go)



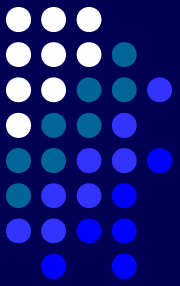
- “Behold I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore **wise** as serpents and **harmless** as doves.” (Matt 10:16)

Jesus Sends Us (But Less Than 2% Go)



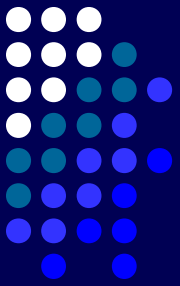
- We are sent to witness to the lost, but we are commanded to be **wise** and **harmless** in doing it.

“And he called unto him the twelve and began to send them forth by two and two and gave them power over unclean spirits.” (Mark 6:7)

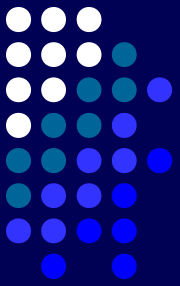
Jesus Sent Them by Two's

When alone, you can still witness and testify.

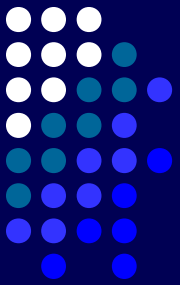
Put Your Heart Into It

and not unto men.”

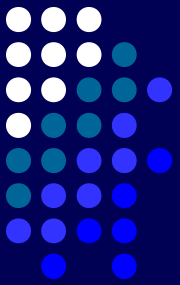

How To Witness



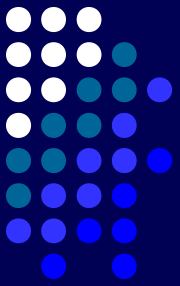
- Let all things be done decently and in order. I Corinthians 14:40
- (That is the purpose of this class. To learn how to witness and try to lead others to Christ, decently and in order.)

How To Talk To Others



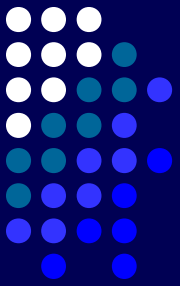
- What if I don't like to talk to others?
 - How do I converse, or talk to others, or carry on a conversation?
- The world's greatest salesmen and greatest conversationalists are NOT the best talkers. They are the best listeners.

Formula For Being A Great Conversationalist



- 75% Listening and 25% Speaking.
- Show interest and enthusiasm.
- Look for conversation items.
- 15-20 minutes at a time, except in unusual circumstances.
- Ask people about things of interest to them.

What to Talk About



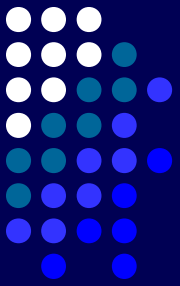
F - Family

O - Occupation (work)

R- Religious Background

M- Message

Three Types of Messages

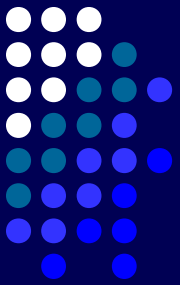


Caller centered – sickness, sorrow, injury, special need, new to area

Church centered – follow up on visit, check on absentee, invite to special meeting

Christ centered – witness and testify to a lost person (soul-winning effort).

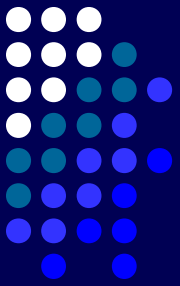

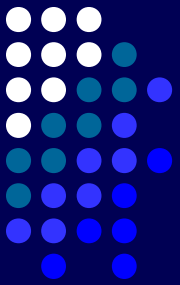

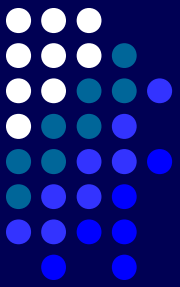
The Romans Road



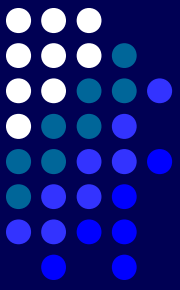
- Romans 3:10 (first verse)
- “As it is written, there is none righteous, no not one.”
 - Are you righteous?
 - If God said none is righteous, , . then how could you be righteous?



- Romans 3:23 (Second Verse)
 - “For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.”
- Romans 5:12 (Third Verse)
 - ...as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.”



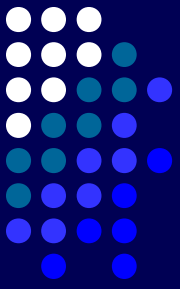
- Romans 5:8 (Fourth Verse)
 - “But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us”.
- Romans 6:23 (Fifth Verse)
 - “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”

If salvation is not a wage,, how do you get it?

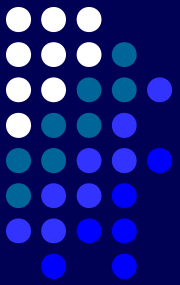

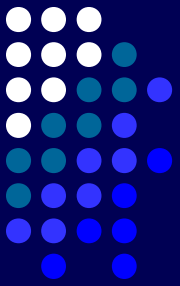
- Romans 10:13 (Seventh Verse)

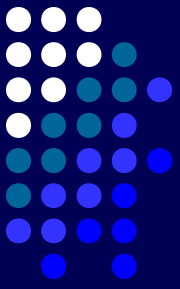

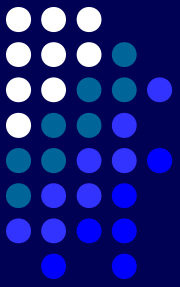
What If I Don't Want To Be A Witness?

- We all have a free will to obey Jesus who commanded us to go into all the world and preach and teach the gospel to every creature.

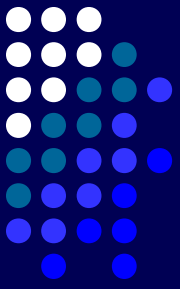
Jesus said: “If ye love me, keep my commandments”, but you have a free will.

What If I Don't Want To Be A Witness?



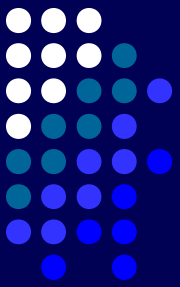
- Join the crowd. Only 2% of Christians witness and testify to others.

What If I Don't Want To Be A Witness?

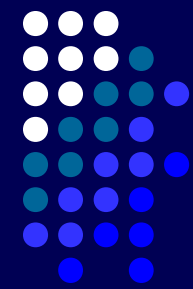

“You Can’t Take It With You”



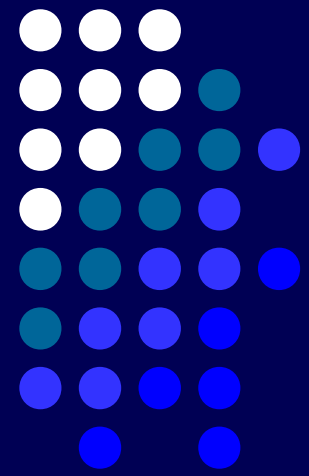
- That is not true.

- “That I might save some.” I Cor 9:22



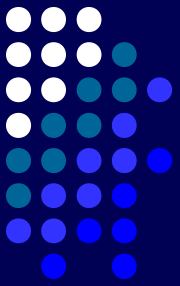

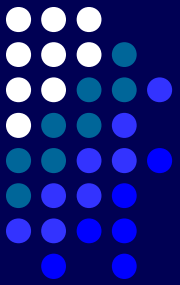

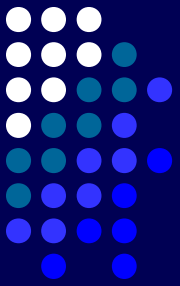
- Daniel 12:3

Attitude



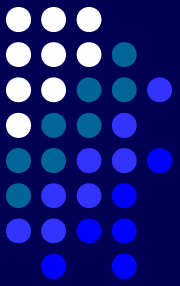
- Pray during the week
- Family agreement
 - Visitation evening – no fights
 - Boost Dad for the evening
 - Best meal of the week

- Church literature

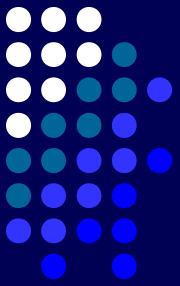
While In The Car



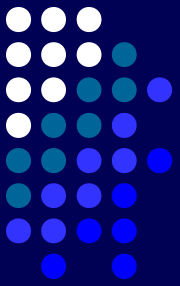
- Select items you will need for visit (tracts, baptism info, about our church)
- Personalize by writing prospects name on literature
- Memorize prospects name

While In The Car

- Decide speaker/supporter
- Brief prayer in car

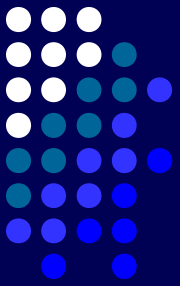


From Car to Front Door



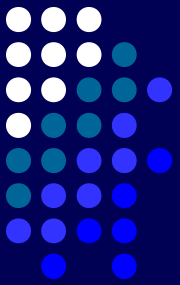
- Always use walkway
- Note conversation pieces
- Be positive

From Car to Front Door



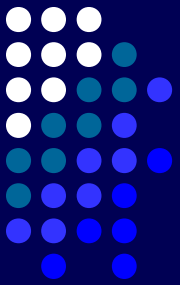
- Smile if observed
- Cease conversation near front porch
- Flash big smile to partner (*make sure partner has been to the visitation class*)

At Front Door



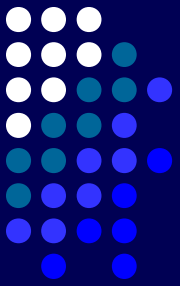
- One definite ring
- Stand back 4 or 5 feet
- Partner is back off porch
- If lady answers (and you are men) step back or shift back on feet.
- If no one is home, leave personalized literature.

The Door Opens



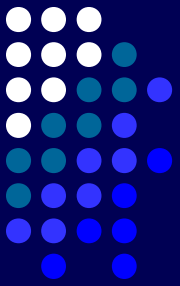
- Hello, Is this the.....residence?
- We are from Northwest Baptist Church. Pastor Rogers asked us to come see you. May we come in for a short visit.
- (why do we say short visit?)

When Not To Enter Home



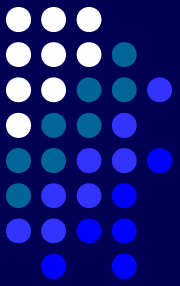
- If spouse is not home and you are two of opposite gender
- If company is present.
- Eating, or about to eat dinner
- Important event (birthday, etc.)
- May we come back another time?
- (what does this question do?)

Entering Home



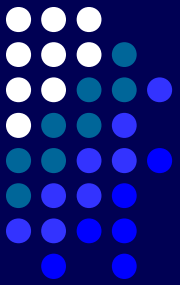
- Don't allow presence of empty beer cans or loaded ash trays change your loving interest.
- Ignore remarks about how the house is a mess.
- *Trap – oh don't worry about the mess, our house looks like this too.*

Dealing With The TV



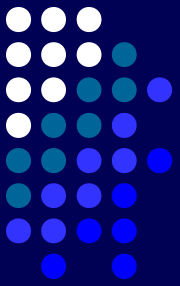
- Speak lower than TV volume, so they can't hear you. This may cause them to turn TV down or off.
- (example of Mr. Bond in Florida)

Dealing With The TV



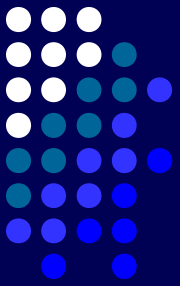
- Sit so they must look away from TV to see you, if possible.
- “If this is your favorite program, perhaps we could come back another time.” *(Most would be reluctant to admit this is a favorite program.)*

The Conversation



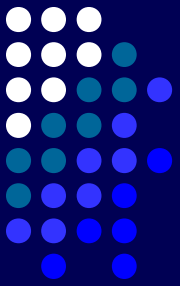
- 75% listening; 25% talking
- Conversation items
- Show genuine interest and enthusiasm
- 20 minutes

What To Talk About



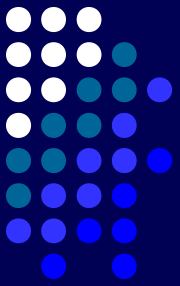
- **F** – Family, hobby, home, furnishings
- **O** –Occupation
- **R** – Religious background
- **M** - Message

Three Types of Message



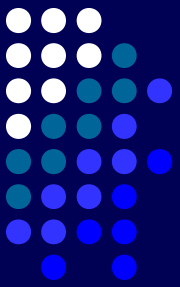
- Caller Centered – Sickness, sorrow, special need
- Church Centered – Prospective member, church business
- Christ centered – Soul winning, baptism

Dale Carnegie Course Summary



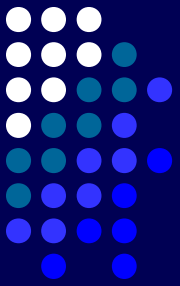
- Dale Carnegie wrote a famous book called How to Win Friends and Influence People

6 Things That Contribute To People Liking You



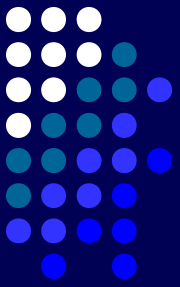
- Become genuinely interested in others.
- Smile (Isaiah 3:9)
- Honor names by using them. (Proverbs 22:1)

6 Things That Contribute To People Liking You



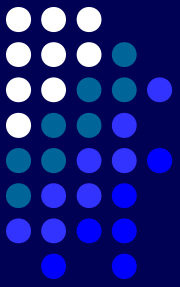
- Be a good listener. (Ecclesiastes 5:3)
- Talk about the others interests.
- Make the other person feel important in a sincere way.

9 Ways to Change People Without Offense or Resentment



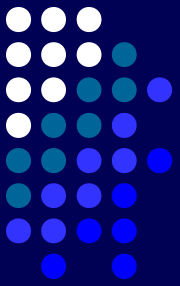
- Begin with praise and honest appreciation.
- Call attention to mistakes indirectly.
- Talk about your mistakes first.
- Ask questions instead of giving orders.

9 Ways to Change People Without Offense or Resentment



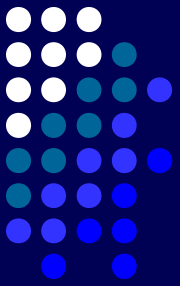
- Let the other person save face.
- Praise the slightest improvement.
- Give the other person a fine reputation to live up to.
- Make the fault seem easy to correct.
- Make the other person happy about what you suggest.

12 Ways To Win People Your Way of Thinking To



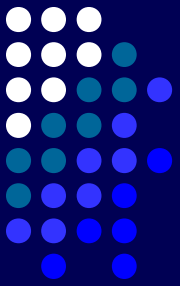
1. Never argue.
2. Never tell another person they are wrong.
3. If you are wrong, admit it emphatically.

12 Ways To Win People Your Way of Thinking To



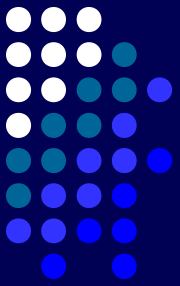
4. Begin in a friendly way.
5. Get the other person saying yes.
6. Let the other person do most of the talking.

Ways to Win People To Your Way of Thinking

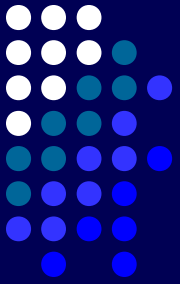


7. Let the other person think that the idea is their's.
8. Empathize
9. Be interested in the other person's ideas and desires.

Ways to Win People To Your Way of Thinking



10. Appeal to the nobler ideas.
11. Dramatize your ideas.
12. Throw down a challenge.
